The New Forest Trust

This new organisation has been set up to promote the conservation of the New Forest.

The New Forest Trust supports activities and organisations that work to look after the flora, fauna and commoning practices of this special area.

The Trust aims to raise money to help in practical ways. It also works to improve public understanding of the essential relationship between conservation and the unique live-stock, woodland and open forest husbandry methods employed by the people who live and work here.

It is a wholly independent and non-political organisation, founded by people who care deeply about preserving the New Forest.

Why establish a Trust?

Many single-issue organisations are concerned about the future of the Forest. But because they are involved with only one aspect of Forest life, they are unable to raise and distribute money for the good of the area as a whole.

Until now, there has been no one body raising money for projects that will ensure the long-term stability of the New Forest.

Now, with your help, the New Forest Trust can raise funds for the future of the New Forest in the widest sense.

How will the money be spent?

The Trust is in close contact with organisations that support Forest life. We do not duplicate any of their work but we will offer them support and financial help where that is possible.

Four projects supported by the Trust are already underway.

- The Stallion Scheme improves the welfare of Forest ponies by limiting the time stallions are out on the Forest to spring and summer months. The Trust helps to pay for fields at New Park where they can stay during the rest of the year.
- The Colt Scheme helps to maintain colt foals as they mature ready for the selection procedure when they might replace existing older stallions.
- Livestock Accident Prevention is a project designed to reduce the number of ponies, cattle, donkeys and deer killed and maimed on Forest roads.
- The Trust has become the tenant for the Beaulieu Road Sale Yard where the Livestock Society holds traditional auctions several times a year. These events help to ensure that ponies will continue to be part of the scene in the New Forest.
